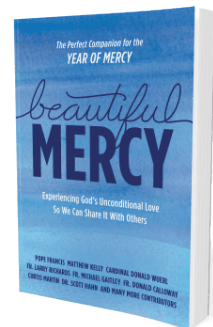

Right now we are experiencing a large increase in food prices, and our donations no longer cover our monthly food expense of **\$4,000.00** per month. *We need your help!*

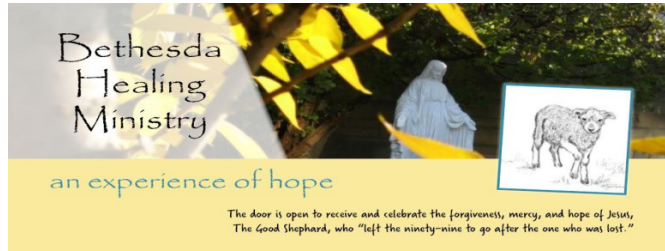

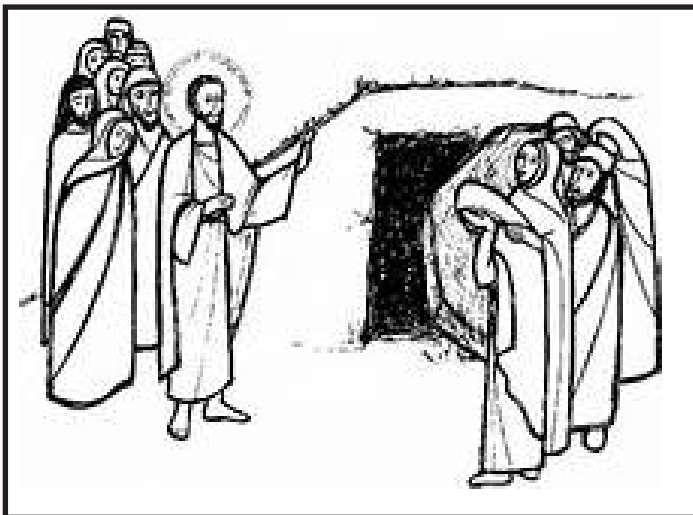
