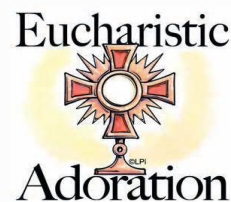

May 5: Habits and Virtues

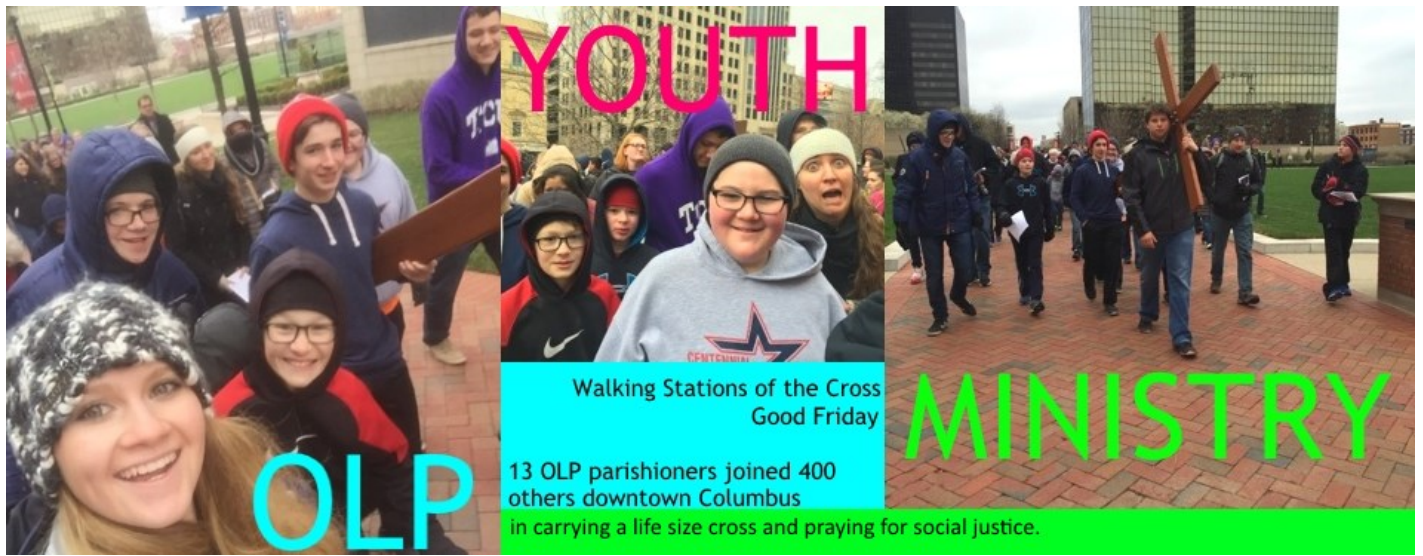
May 12: Vice and Sin

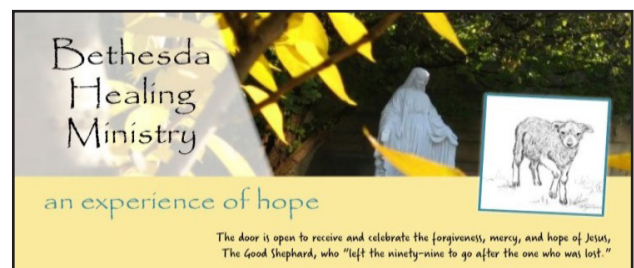
