Thank you to the OLP Knights who participated in the clean-up of the parish **Festival**. It was a great event for the parish and I am grateful for everyone who stepped up to help.

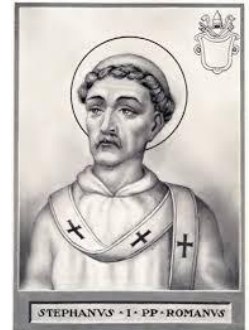

**Pope St.  
Stephen I  
Martyr  
?-257  
August 2**



St. Stephen was by birth a Roman, and, being promoted to holy orders, was made archdeacon under the holy Popes St. Cornelius and St. Lucius. Pope St. Lucius having suffered martyrdom, St. Stephen was chosen to succeed him, and was elected Pope on the May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 253 AD.

The controversy concerning the re-baptizing of heretics gave St. Stephen much trouble. It is the teaching of the Catholic Church, that Baptism given in the name of the three persons of the Blessed Trinity is valid, though it be conferred by a heretic. St. Stephen suffered himself patiently to be traduced as a favorer of heresy in approving heretical baptism, not doubting but those great men who by mistaken zeal were led astray would, when the heat of the dispute had subsided, calmly open their eyes to the truth.

Thus by his zeal he preserved the integrity of faith, and by his toleration and forbearance saved many souls.

The persecutions under the Emperor Valerian becoming violent, he assembled the faithful together in the underground tombs of the martyrs, to celebrate Mass

and to exhort them to remain true to Christ.

On August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 257 AD, while seated in his pontifical chair, he was beheaded by the order of Emperor Valerian; and the chair is still shown, stained with his blood.

## Annual Blue Mass at St. Timothy's

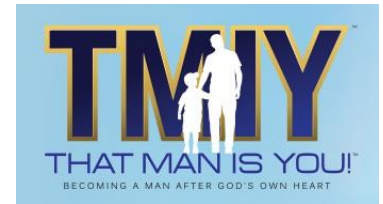
